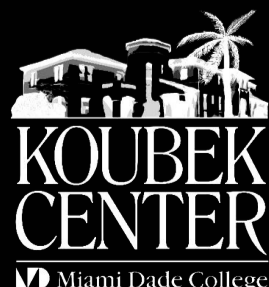

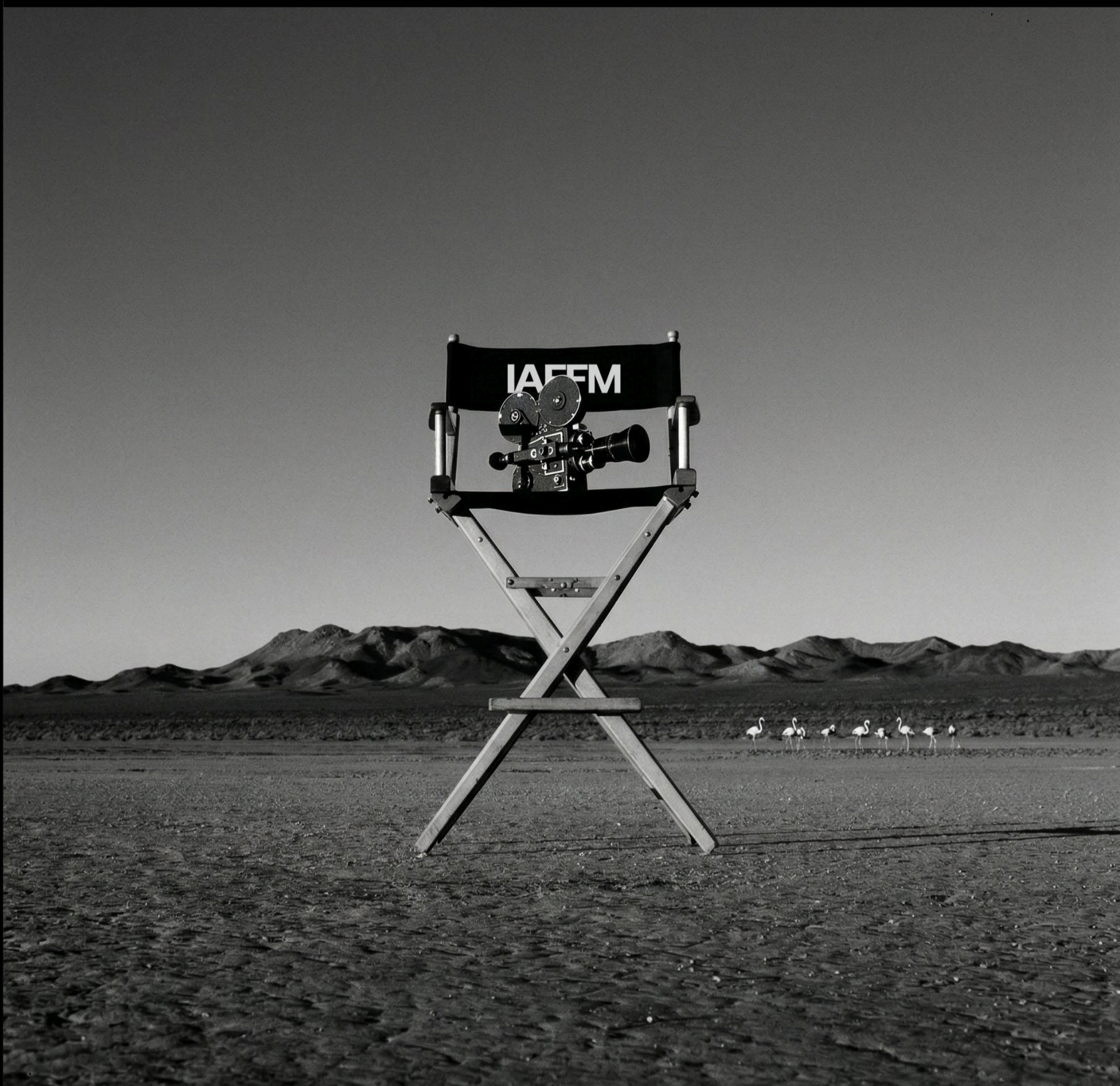
A CURATED PROGRAM BY IBERO-AMERICAN FILM FESTIVAL MIAMI

LOS DOMINGOS



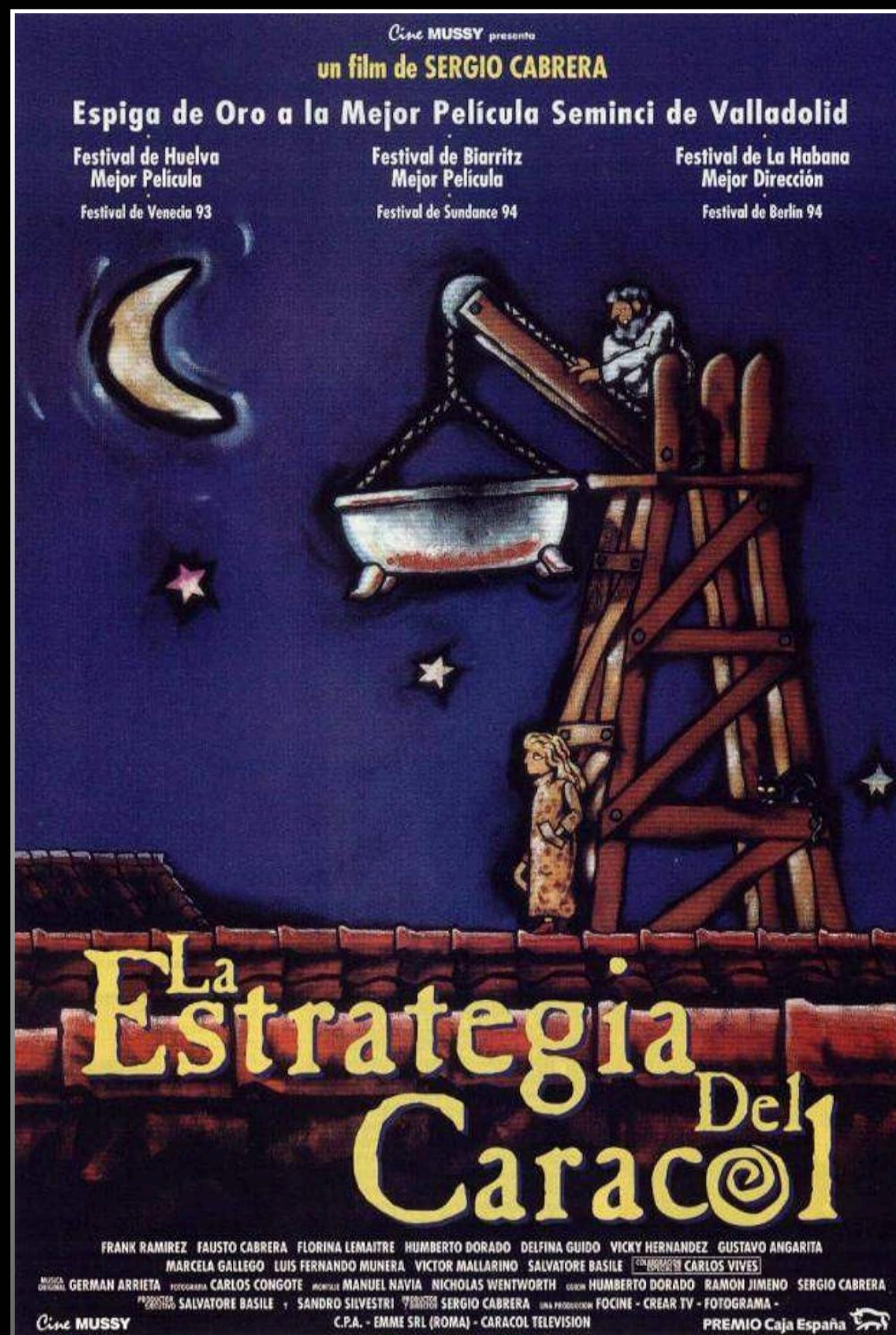

The Strategy of the Snail (1993) is a Colombian comedy-drama directed by Sergio Cabrera about a group of tenants in Bogotá who, facing eviction from their home, devise a clever plan to stay, led by a Spanish anarchist exile and a lawyer. The film, a major success in Colombia, uses humor and social commentary to explore themes of poverty, dignity, and community resistance against a landlord and his attorney. It was Colombia's submission for the Academy Award for Best International Film that year.

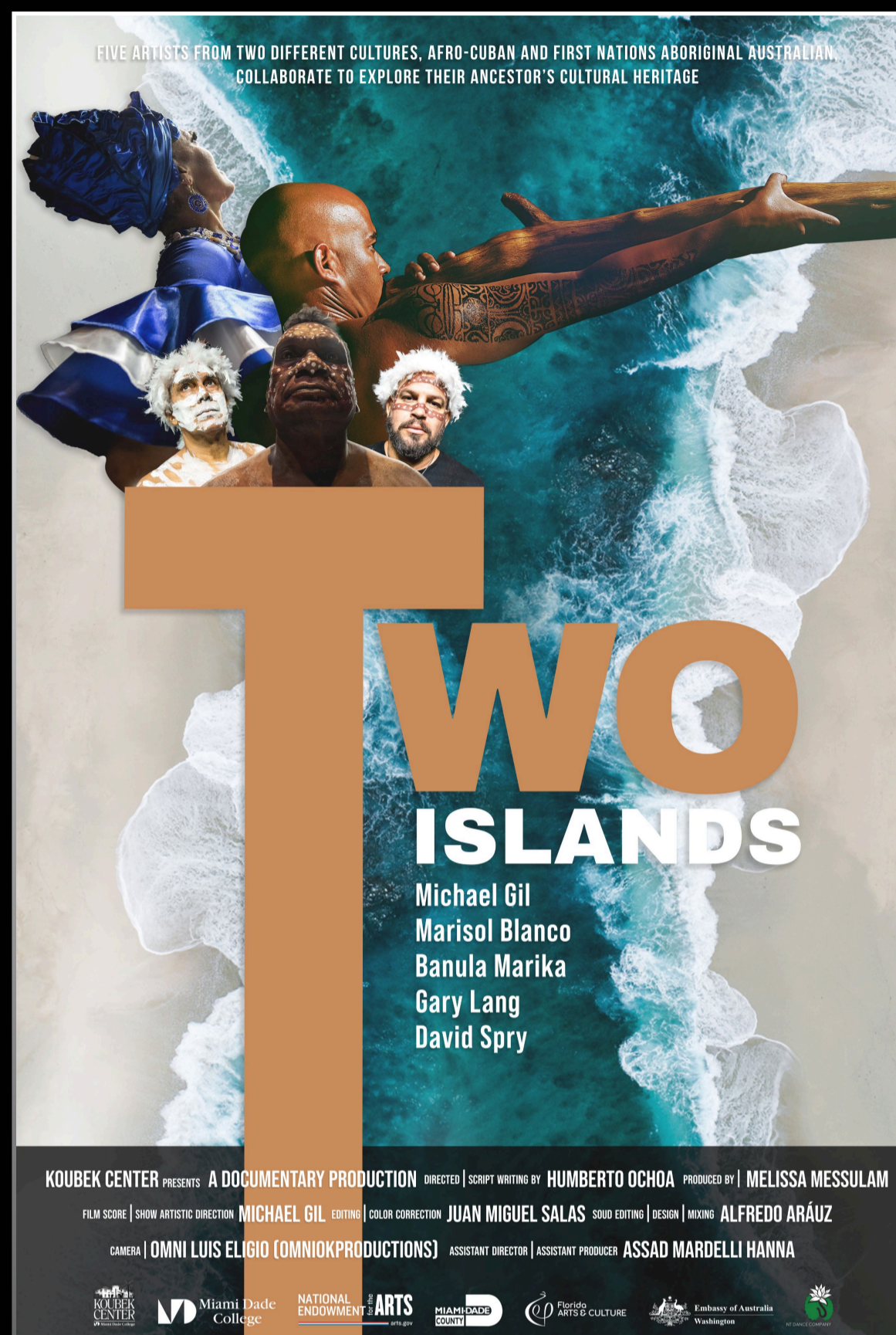
